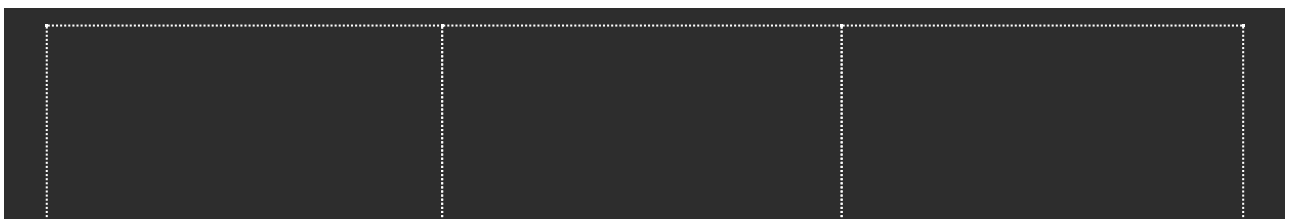

More information on the race itself:

On September 2, 2017, Bhutan will see the 8th running of the Tour of the Dragon, a one-day mountain bike race from Bumthang to Thimphu over 268 km or 166.5 miles, climbing over four mountain passes with a total climbing ascent of 13,100 feet. This race is not only considered one of the most difficult (and craziest) one-day races, but also the most scenic with the Bumthang - Thimphu highway passing through stunning, scenic river valleys, dense, rich pine and cypress forests, terraced farms, and prayer-flag-strewn mountain passes.
